Speed/volume data collected on W University Ave, 85th percentile speed 35 mph
11/2018

Speed/volume data collected in Boulder Pointe before the Woody Way Gate removal
11/2019

Transportation Commission Meeting, Woody Way Gate Introduction
12/2019

Transportation Commission Meeting, presented Woody Way gate 'before' speed and volumes
2/2020

Determined Presidio was over 90% occupied and Woody Way gate was removed
4/2020

Speed/volume data collected on W University Ave, 85th percentile Speed 31 mph
6/2020

Transportation Commission Meeting, W University Ave traffic calming options presentation
10/2020

Transportation Commission Meeting, medians selected for trial run on University Ave
12/2020

Before speed/volume data gathered for the medians 85th percentile speed 31 mph
4/2021

Transportation Commission Meeting, trial median plans presented
6/2021

Medians and radar feedback signs installed
6/2021

After speed/volume data gathered for the medians 85th Percentile speed 29 mph
9/2021

Transportation Commission Meeting, decided to scrape the medians due to neighborhood dissatisfaction.
10/2021

Transportation Commission Meeting, presented several alternative solutions, traffic circles selected
12/2021

Temporary traffic circle installed at Tombaugh
2/2022

Additional temporary traffic circle installed at Majestic
4/2022

After speed/volume data gathered for the temporary traffic circles 85th Percentile speed 27 mph
4/2022

Transportation Commission Meeting, temporary traffic circle results presented, circles approved
6/2022

Ardurra hired to create the final design of the circles and additional traffic calming in the neighborhood.
10/2022

Citizen Petition for expanded Boulder Pointe Traffic Calming
11/2022

Transportation Commission Meeting, 60% design plans for the circles presented and approved.
