Hi Patrick and Jaime,

I met with Thom Phelan from Tesano Contracting at 614 W Santa Fe this morning. The stone he had ordered for the chimney repair is not a close enough match. He and Trevor Soper are proposing to recycle some of the stone being removed from under that back porch for the new footing and rough cutting it to match the chimney's missing pieces. I think this is the best approach after having exhausted other material options. The new material that was originally intended for the chimney will be used to face the foundation under the porch. This email is documenting that I have given this the ok. What is the best way to document it for Building Safety? Do we need to add notes in Bluebeam or do we wait if there are new foundation adjustments made and add comments then?

Thanks for your help on this and let me know if there is anything I can do to help keep the repairs moving forward.
