# Safe Streets Master Plan - IGA

- In 2024, MetroPlan applied to the Federal Highways Administration Safe Streets and Roads for All Program for supplemental grant funding to procure a Safe Streets Master Plan
- The City has previously allocated \$250,000 to create a Vision Zero Action Plan and \$250,000 to create a Transportation Master Plan
- This project will fund a consultant to develop the City's Transportation Master Plan and several supplemental materials



# Safe Streets Master Plan - IGA

## Project Costs

- Grant Award: \$2,140,000 (80% of project)
- Local Match: \$535,000 (20% of project)
  - City of Flagstaff - \$500,000
  - Mountain Line - \$25,000
  - Coconino County - \$10,000
- **Total Project Cost: \$2,675,000**



# Safe Streets Master Plan - IGA

## MetroPlan Role

- Provide grant administration
- Contract for third-party consultant services
- Coordinate closely with City of Flagstaff on project direction

## City Role

- Co-direct the work of the third-party consultant
- Review and accept deliverables from the third-party consultant relating to City facilities or policy and regulatory documents



# Safe Streets Master Plan - IGA

## Committed Project Components

- Complete Street Guidelines
- Master Plan
- Review and revisions of engineering standards
- Interactive web-based mapping tool



# Safe Streets Master Plan - IGA

## Project Status

- Conducted 30+ stakeholder interviews to work towards scope development
- Ongoing meetings with City staff, MetroPlan, Mountain Line, and Coconino County to develop scope
- Procurement of a third-party consultant anticipated to open in late Spring 2025
