

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE GANG & IMMIGRATION INTELLIGENCE TEAM ENFORCEMENT MISSION (GIITEM) STATE GANG TASK FORCE

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Agreement shall be to enhance law enforcement services concerning the criminal activities of street gangs, through the cooperative efforts of the Department of Public Safety (“DPS”) and the City of Flagstaff, acting on behalf of its Flagstaff Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Flagstaff Police Department agrees to assign two (2) AZ P.O.S.T. certified sworn law enforcement officer to DPS and its Gang & Immigration Intelligence Team Enforcement Mission “GIITEM”, on a full-time basis; and

WHEREAS, DPS agrees to reimburse the Flagstaff Police Department on a monthly basis for seventy-five (75%) percent of payroll expenses of the officer related to the assignment. DPS will also reimburse overtime but must be a minimum of 40 hours GIITEM related work in any given week.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the State of Arizona through its Department of Public Safety, hereinafter referred to as “DPS” and the City of Flagstaff, acting on behalf of its Flagstaff Police Department, hereinafter referred to as “Agency”, attached hereto (“IGA”), which shall become effective July 1, 2025 (“Effective Date”).

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
