PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Hunger Action Month is a nationwide, month-long hunger awareness campaign intended to raise food, funds, and awareness about hunger in communities across the United States; and

WHEREAS, In Arizona, over 1 million people suffer from food insecurity; and

WHEREAS, Lack of consistent access to food is a problem for one in five adults, one in four children, and one in seven seniors in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, The need for hunger relief services is even higher in Coconino County, with 16.1% of the population considered food insecure and over half of children in Flagstaff qualifying for free or reduced lunch; and

WHEREAS, The Flagstaff Family Food Center provides the most extensive and wide-reaching emergency food support for the Flagstaff and broader community, serving 2,300 individuals through all programs across northern Arizona per day; and



HUNGER ACTION MONTH


