

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-52

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL DECLARING AS A PUBLIC RECORD THAT CERTAIN DOCUMENT FILED WITH THE CITY CLERK AND ENTITLED “2025 AMENDMENTS TO FLAGSTAFF CITY CODE, TITLE 13, ENGINEERING DESIGN STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR NEW INFRASTRUCTURE”

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-802 a municipality may enact or amend provisions of the City Code by reference to a public record, provided that the adopting ordinance is published in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Flagstaff (“City”) wish to declare the document entitled “2025 Amendments to Flagstaff City Code, Title 13, Engineering Design Standards and Specifications for New Infrastructure” to be a public record and to permit its adoption by reference into the City Code; and

WHEREAS, the Flagstaff City Code, Title 13, *Engineering Design Standards and Specifications for New Infrastructure*, contains engineering and design standards and specifications setting forth minimum acceptable design and construction practices, and these standards and specifications are periodically amended to reflect new and best practices, changes to other codes that are incorporated by reference within these standards, clerical corrections, legal considerations and input from the community; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Capital Improvements Division in consultation with other Divisions has evaluated the construction methodology commonly known as micro-trenching for the installation of underground fiber-optic cabling within public streets and found that the method provides for more rapid deployment of new fiber-optic facilities with manageable impacts to public roadways and infrastructure.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

That certain document known as “2025 Amendments to Flagstaff City Code, Title 13, Engineering Design Standards and Specifications for New Infrastructure” attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby declared to be a public record, and one (1) paper copy and one (1) electronic copy, maintained in compliance with A.R.S. § 44-7041, shall remain on file with the City Clerk and kept available for public use and inspection.
