

# CITY OF FLAGSTAFF – OFFICE OF THE MAYOR PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, safe and affordable housing is not a privilege, but a fundamental necessity that shapes individual well-being, public health, educational achievement, and access to opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Flagstaff continues to face severe housing pressures, with a median home price across all property types of \$689,000 and average rents above \$2,234 per month. These figures remain out of reach for the average household earning \$69,700 per year, and even further beyond the means of essential workers such as teachers, police officers, and firefighters; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Flagstaff remains committed to expanding housing opportunities, implementing solutions, and delivering local programs that create long-term affordability, reduce displacement, and challenge opposition to inclusive development; and

**WHEREAS**, as federal rhetoric and policies increasingly criminalize those without shelter, Flagstaff stands in solidarity with vulnerable community members by choosing housing-first approaches grounded in compassion, dignity, and evidence-based practice; and



## HOUSING AMERICA MONTH


Let us reject the idea that housing is a privilege and embrace our shared responsibility to make it a foundation of equity and opportunity for all.
