

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF WOODY MOUNTAIN ROAD AND U.S. ROUTE 66

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation and City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for the design and construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of West Route 66 and Woody Mountain Road;

WHEREAS, The Arizona State Legislature passed Senate Bill 1737 which appropriated \$1,900,000 to be distributed to the City of Flagstaff for the design and construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Woody Mountain Road and U.S. Route 66.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Department of Transportation and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
