

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF ARIZONA AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE ARIZONA STATE MATCH ADVANTAGE FOR RURAL TRANSPORTATION (AZ SMART) FUND AWARD FOR THE DOWNTOWN MILE SAFETY AND CONNECTIVITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, in 2022, the Arizona Legislature established the AZ SMART Fund and program, and authorized the State Transportation Board, among other things, to award grants to Eligible Applicants for design and other engineering services (“DOES”), grant development and submission (“GDS”), and Match for a surface transportation project for which the Applicant has submitted a Federal Grant application and received an award agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff has applied for and received a U.S. Department of Transportation, INFRA grant award in the amount of \$32,460,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff has applied for and received an award for an AZ SMART match in the amount of \$3,000,000 for the Downtown Mile Safety and Connectivity Improvement project; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona and City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement to establish each party’s obligations and responsibilities related to the City’s receipt of the AZ SMART award for the Downtown Mile Safety and Connectivity Improvement Project.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the State of Arizona and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
