

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-28

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF, AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 116 E. BUTLER AVE; PROVIDING FOR DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AUTHORITY FOR CLERICAL CORRECTIONS, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the City has authority to acquire and dispose of real property, pursuant to Article I, Section 3 of the Flagstaff City Charter; and

WHEREAS, acquisition and disposition of real property is to be approved by ordinance, pursuant to Article VII, Section 5 of the Flagstaff City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City also has authority to dispose of real property interests pursuant to Article VII, Section 5 and Article VIII, Section 9; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to dispose of certain real property interest located at 116 E. Butler Ave.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the disposition of the real property identified in the attached Exhibit A. The real property interests may be disposed of through a sale or similar transfer of interest.

SECTION 2. Delegation of Authority

The Mayor, City Manager, Planning and Development Services Director, Real Estate Manager, City Attorney or their delegates or agents, are hereby authorized and directed to take all steps and execute all documents necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of the code adopted herein are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance or any part of the code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the

decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. Clerical Corrections

The City Clerk is hereby authorized to correct clerical and grammatical errors, if any, related to this ordinance, and to make formatting changes appropriate for purposes of clarity, form, or consistency with the Flagstaff City Code.

SECTION 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days following adoption by the City Council.
