Background



- Policy assessment completed in December 2022
- Began CEASE Designation Training in April 2023
- Shared implemented recommendations with Council in June 2023
- Applied for Anti-Human Trafficking Grant in coordination with FIAT in September 2024
- Awarded Grant in December 2024
- Preparing for kick-off FIAT Training in 2025

Anti-Human Trafficking Grant

- Awarded by Arizona Department of Public Safety
- Law enforcement services and programs to reduce human trafficking within Arizona
- Supported by HB2897
- \$428,658 for fiscal year 2025-2026
 - \$22,967 to Northland Family Help Center
 - \$405,691 to Flagstaff Police Department

- Provide victim services
- Coordinated community response to identify victims
- Victim advocacy and service coordination during law enforcement operations
