- Established in 2005 by City Council and Board of Supervisors
- Mission
 - Promote the safety of citizens
 - Efficient and just treatment for offenders
 - Protection and healing of victims
 - Work toward prevention of crime
 - Reduction of recidivism
- Purpose is to study criminal justice and make improvements





CJCC Director



- Serves as liaison to CJCC and partners
- Coordinates CJCC committees and workgroups
- Maintains CJCC webpage on County website
- Analyzes policies and data
- Conducts legal and scientific research
- Prepares reports in response to goals and objectives
- Consults with entities in the criminal justice system
- Orients new members

- IGA captures the City's commitment to support half of the position and operational expenses
- City will pay invoices quarterly
- Annual reconciliation to adjust for any variances
- Funding approved beginning FY 2021-2022
