# Library Site Specific Plan

## **Downtown Library Tier 2 begins June 1st**

- Open Monday through Friday 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- 25 patrons at a time
- Limited seating and study areas
- Computers available up to 1-hour sessions
- Library materials are available and self-serve kiosk for check out
- Curbside and phone in reference services will continue

## **East Side Library Tier 2 begins June 2nd**

- Monday and Wednesday from 2:00 to 6:00 p.m.
- Friday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- 15 patrons at a time

# Jay Lively Ice Arena capacity

- Tier 3 beginning June 1 which may allow increased capacity throughout the facility while maintaining the space needed for physical distancing for the following programs/areas:
  - Public skate
  - Locker rooms
  - Spectator area
  - Lobby
- Tier 4 beginning June 28<sup>th</sup> includes opening to capacity
