**WHEREAS**, the month of September is recognized as National Suicide Prevention Month to raise awareness, spread hope, and spark meaningful action to ensure that all people can talk openly about suicide prevention and have access to help and support resources; and

**WHEREAS**, suicide is a major public health issue that requires vigilant attention and preventative action. The Arizona Public Health Association recorded at least 1,082 deaths by suicide in Arizona in 2024 and suicide was listed as the ninth leading cause of death in the state; and


**WHEREAS**, the 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline and other local and national programs provide immediate, life-saving support to people facing their darkest moments; and


