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About the project

The City is exploring options for landscaping and public art at the Spruce Wash Wedge Detention Basin, located at E. Cedar Avenue and N. West Street. This detention basin plays an important role in mitigating flood impacts in the Grandview and Sunnyside neighborhoods.

To gather community input on potential public art at the site, the City conducted an online survey. The survey received strong participation, and the feedback collected is being reviewed. The survey is now closed.

Future opportunities for comment on public art at this location will be made available to ensure the community has meaningful opportunities to review, respond, and help guide the direction moving forward.
