

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY AND FIRE MANAGEMENT, AN AGENCY OF THE STATE OF ARIZONA AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR A NORTHERN ARIZONA WILDLAND FIRE TRAINING FACILITY

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management (DFFM) and City of Flagstaff ("City") desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for a Wildfire Management Station and Training Center;

WHEREAS, the FY26 General Appropriations Act (SB1735) allocates to DFFM \$4,000,000 to fund the construction of a new operational base for the Flagstaff Fire Department's Wildfire Management Program and provide wildfire suppression training for local and regional firefighters;

WHEREAS, the City has allocated \$650,000 for costs of the design of the Facility and DFFM will disburse \$4,000,000 for construction of the Facility.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
