# A Regional Asset

## The City of Flagstaff was awarded a grant from the state



Senate Bill 1735 Appropriations (through Dept. of Fire and Forestry Management) is for \$4,000,000



The City has budgeted \$650k for the design costs



There will still be a gap to complete it all, but this is a giant step forward for the Department and Region



# A Regional Asset



## Wildfire Management Station

Currently located at the Airport in a loaned facility

Not the correct type of facility and very old

Adjacent to the airport tarmac and is not in the correct or ideal location

No current funding to replace

## Training Classroom

Currently located next to the Wildcat Treatment plant

A modular facility placed in 2008 with limited space

Not in the correct location inside the treatment plant gates

No current funding to replace

# A Regional Asset

## Wildfire Management Station

Will house the Flagstaff Fire Departments Wildland Fire Management (WFM) Division

Will provide much needed office space for WFM staff

Will provide apparatus and equipment bay and storage space

They will be the subject matter experts to assist with regional wildfire trainings

## Classroom

Will serve as the regional training classroom for all-risk trainings

Will allow for larger outside trainings to be hosted for regional purposes

Will significantly increase the classroom capacity from the current facility

Will be the primary classroom for the N. AZ Greater Flagstaff Regional Academy

# A regional asset

Build time is estimated at 2-3 years out
