Title of Issue: Prohibit ICE from operating on City property

Further Details:

The purpose of this ordinance is to prevent federal agents from using city-owned property as a base for civil immigration raids. Doing so protects our immigrant communities and ensures that our public spaces remain accessible for community use. ICE-Free zone ordinances have already been adopted and implemented in multiple cities, big and small, throughout the nation, including Minneapolis; Berkeley and Los Angeles, CA; Albuquerque; Denver; Chicago and Aurora, IL; Jersey City and Hoboken, NJ; New York City; Seattle; and Providence, RI. There is no Arizona state law that prohibits cities from adopting an ordinance like this; the Tucson City Council has directed staff to draft an ordinance to prohibit ICE from operating on city property.
