# History

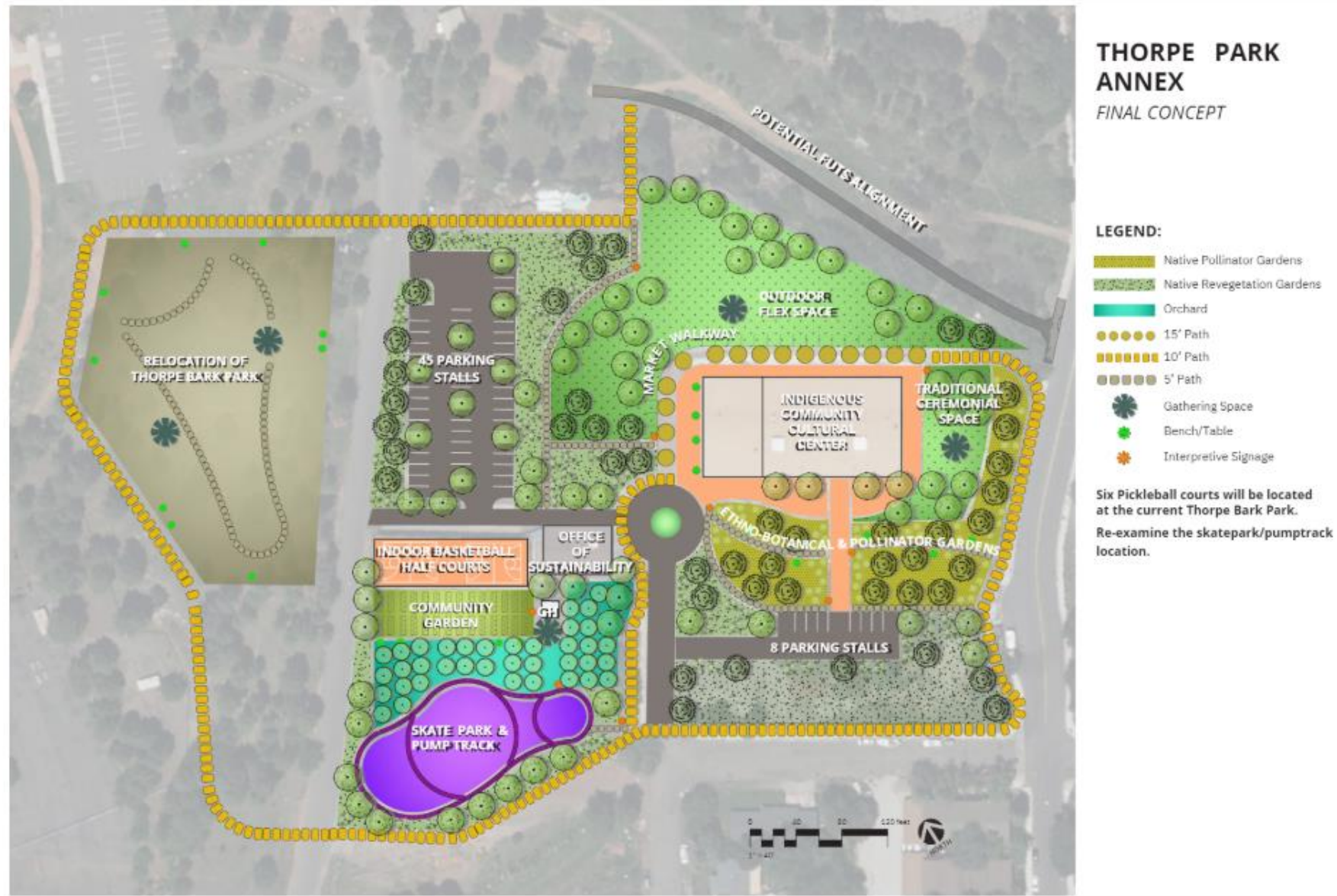
## Indigenous Community Cultural Center (ICCC)

- Discussion in Indigenous Community for Decades
- 2016-2017 Indigenous Community Forums
- Forums produced Recommendations included a dream of an ICCC; Recommendations accepted by City Council in Oct. 2017

# Procurement Process

## Indigenous Community Cultural Center (ICCC)

- Dec. 2024, the City launched an RSOQ to identify a key partner
- In May 2025, ICF was identified as the non-profit organization and key partner
- July 2025 – January 2026, discussion meetings with ICF and/or internal core staff to finalize the MOU
- The purpose of the MOU is to enable ICF and COF to collaborate in the development of the ICCC.



# COF and ICF

## General Roles and Responsibilities

- Planning, design, and development of appropriate ICCC space.
  - ICF is primarily responsible for the vision and implementation of the ICCC and its programming.
- Identification of a location for viable and feasible ICF office space during the development of the ICCC.
- ICF will be responsible for renovation of Fleet Management Building, including COF collaboration when involving COF funding.



# COF and ICF

## General Roles and Responsibilities

- ICF will:
  - Assume primary responsibility for fundraising, with assistance from COF.
  - Hire personnel using secured donor funds and develop organizational structure to allow management of ICCC.
  - Develop programming for the ICCC.
  - Develop plans for specified outdoor spaces, in coordination with the Thorpe Park Annex Concept Design.

# Next Steps

- Timelines for the following remain in development:
  - Building repair and renovation
  - Fundraising
  - ICF organizational development
  - Continued program development
