
WHEREAS, it is important to celebrate the contributions to preservation made by dedicated community partners and volunteers, including the Heritage Preservation Commission; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor Becky Daggett, Mayor of the City of Flagstaff, Arizona do hereby proclaim May 2026, as


