

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF ARIZONA AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF WOODY MOUNTAIN ROAD AND U.S. ROUTE 66

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona appropriated \$1,900,000 to be distributed to the City of Flagstaff for the design and construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Woody Mountain Road and U.S. Route 66; and

WHEREAS, the traffic signal is currently under construction and approximately 45% complete; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona through its Department of Transportation and the City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for the operation and maintenance of the traffic signal; and

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by A.R.S. 48-572 to enter into this intergovernmental agreement with State of Arizona.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Department of Transportation and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
