

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-35

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF ARIZONA AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR PRELIMINARY DESIGN SCOPING FOR FORT VALLEY ROAD

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff desires to move forward with design work to improve Fort Valley Road from Navajo Road to Sechrist Elementary School with sidewalk infrastructure and road widening, and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona through its Department of Transportation has agreed to assist this work with the acquisition of federal funds for this design work and to serve as the designated agent for the project; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona and City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for Preliminary Design Scoping for Fort Valley Road from Navajo Road to Sechrist Elementary School to set forth the terms of this design project; and

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by A.R.S. 48-572 to enter into this intergovernmental agreement with State of Arizona.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Department of Transportation and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
