

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING THE CURBSIDE MANAGEMENT PLAN; PROVIDING FOR DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to regulate standing or parking of vehicles, pursuant to A.R.S. § 28-627(A)(1); and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to regulate the use and improve City streets, alleys, and sidewalks pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-276(A)(1); and

WHEREAS, in 2016 the City adopted a Comprehensive Parking Management Program as set forth in the Flagstaff City Code Section 9-01-001-0014, to regulate traffic and make street improvements in Downtown, the Southside, and the surrounding areas impacted by high parking demand ("the ParkFlag District"); and

WHEREAS, in 2025 the City retained a consultant to assist with preparation of a Curbside Management Plan for the ParkFlag District.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General

The Curbside Management Plan attached hereto is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Delegation of Authority

The Economic Vitality Director, City Engineer, and Parking Manager are hereby authorized to implement and administer the Curbside Management Plan consistent with Comprehensive Parking Management Program.

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
