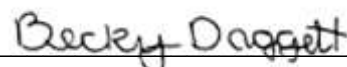
WHEREAS, much of their work takes place behind the scenes, yet their impact is felt every day across City operations and the services provided to our community.

WHEREAS, their behind-the-scenes contributions often go unrecognized, yet their impact is felt daily across every level of city operations.

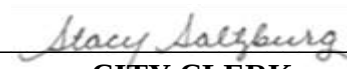
