

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AND COCONINO COUNTY FOR ELECTION SERVICES FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION, IF NECESSARY, TO BE HELD ON JULY 21, 2026 AND THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Coconino County for Election Services; and

WHEREAS, Coconino County has authority under A.R.S. Title 16 and 19 to conduct elections and responsibility for establishing and staffing polling places, preparing and counting ballots, and providing voting equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Coconino County Recorder has the authority to maintain voter registration rolls and to conduct early balloting under A.R.S. 16-162 and A.R.S. Title 17, Ch. 4, Art. 8; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff is authorized to contract with the board of supervisors and county recorder for election services under A.R.S. 16-408 and desires to use the election services of Coconino County to conduct its election.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between Coconino County and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
