Rocla Concrete Tie, Inc. proposes to construct a state-of-art concrete rail road tie manufacturing facility in Ft. Pierce which will employ 40 high skilled / high wage jobs and require a capital investment of approximately \$10,000,000.00. However, it has come to our attention that are several transportation impediments surrounding the proposed Ft. Pierce site. Namely, the intersection of Georgia Ave. and US-1, is currently insufficient and potentially dangerous. Therefore, Rocla Concrete Tie, Inc. requests financial assistance through the State of Florida EDTF grant program to alleviate these aforementioned impediments.
