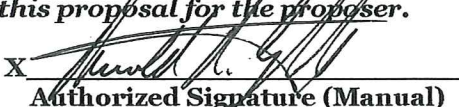

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am pleased and enthusiastic to submit a proposal for RFP: 2015-043, South Hutchinson Island Redevelopment. It is our understanding that you want to develop the property (.73 acres) just west of Jetty Park for much needed additional parking and at the same time create a unique experience for visitors and locals.

We propose to build and operate 38 paid parking spaces utilizing a ticket kiosk and to provide landscaping, lighting (using local and state requirements) and pedestrian access as needed.

We further propose to build and operate a tourist and local attraction further rounding out the entire Ft. Pierce experience. This attraction will be an observatory tower in the form of the exact replica of the former observation tower used in 1942 to watch for ships and submarines off our coast.

As you know, this tower existed for many years after the Navy left Ft. Pierce. The original location of the observation tower was just East of the proposed project property. The original tower now sits in the City Public Works compound off Savannah Road. Due to its current condition the existing tower cannot be used. In order to make this attraction sustainable, a small access fee will be charged. This fee will be minimal, but necessary to help pay for maintenance and upkeep.

We additionally propose in order to make this project sustainable to lease or control the parking associated with Jetty Park in the form of metered parking or ticket kiosk. It is our intent and interest to continue free parking from 6 AM to 12 PM and after 12 PM paid parking.

We also suggest to share 50/50 any revenues received after expenses with the City of Ft. Pierce. We move for the City to retain ownership and lease to proposer the property described above for a period agreeable to all parties.

All work to be completed in a timely manner and we propose to work closely with the City to expedite permits, grants and State requirements.

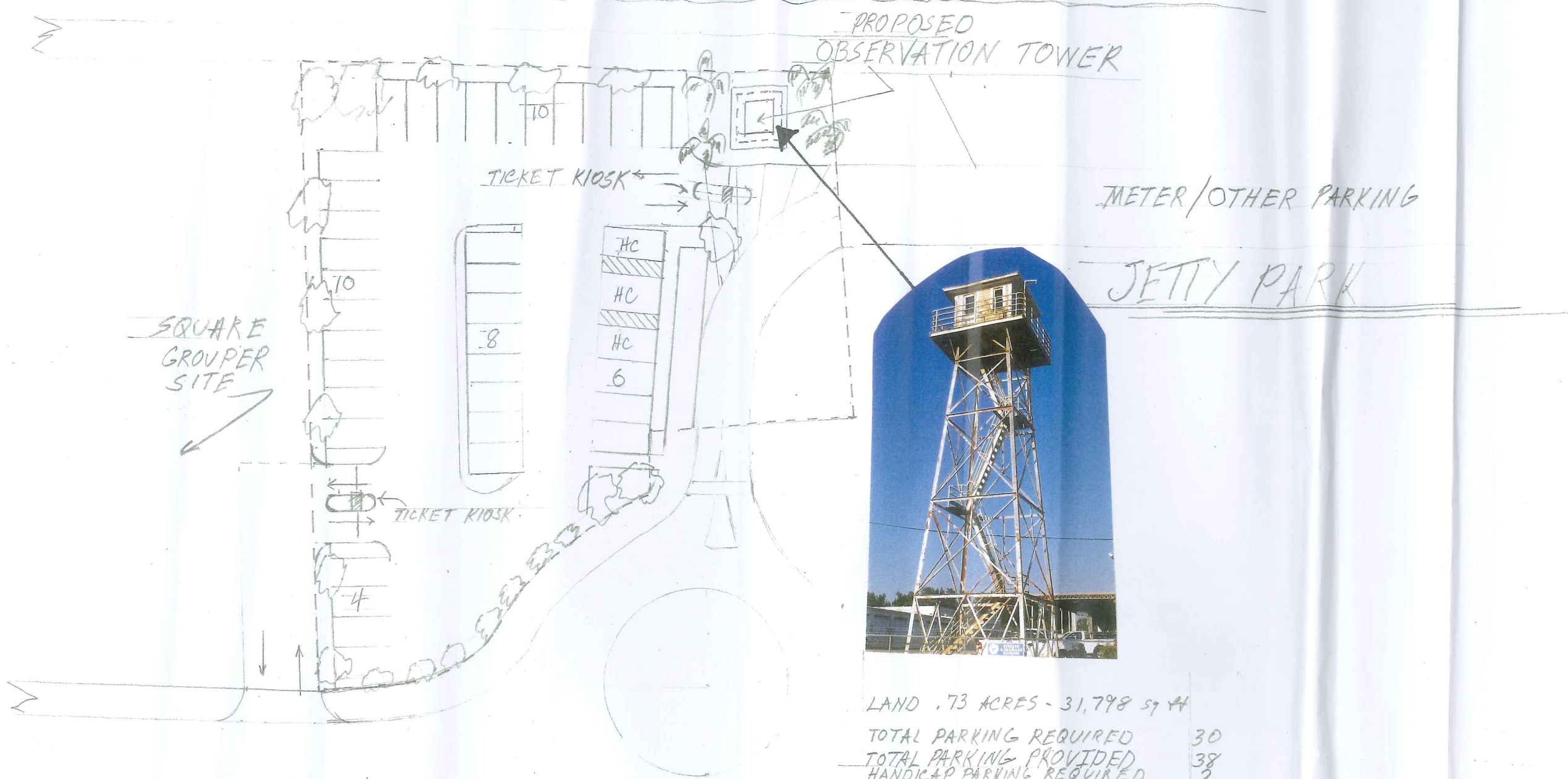

Scope of Work:

1. Build and operate a 38 space parking lot utilizing, a kiosk, automated parking with a control system meeting City and ADA regulations.
2. Build and maintain a storm water maintenance plan using a French style drainage system.
3. The landscaping shall continue using coconut palms characteristic of Jetty Park but also introduce native oak trees, bamboo, and other easily maintainable species that survive and thrive in a beach environment.
4. There shall be shared access to the adjoining site to the West by an entrance and exit maintained by an automated parking control system.
5. There shall be incorporated into the landscaping plan a unique lighting layout using ground lighting, tree lighting and directional lighting complying with City, State and environmental regulations.
6. Create a sustainable financial business plan in order to maintain the parking area for many years.
7. Build and operate a tourist and local attraction in the form of a replica of the old observation tower which the public will be encouraged to use and enjoy. The experience of climbing this historic replica and the view from the top will attract visitors for years to come.
8. In order to be sustainably contiguous the proposer proposes to lease or operate under separate agreement the parking area located to the East and supply and maintain either parking meters or an automated parking control system in which 50% of the after expenses revenue will be split with the City of Ft. Pierce or 10% of gross sales or \$2500 per year.

We recognize that there are many details to overcome in order to accomplish this project, but the idea is sound and the fact we must pay for all improvements in order to maintain the highest standard of excellence.

It is not feasible to sustain this property without the City of Ft. Pierce as a participant in a Public/Private partnership.

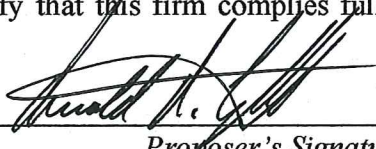

Observation Tower

As most of you know, the United States Navy occupied Hutchinson Island from 1943 to 1945, but even before that the observation tower was erected and maintained by the Coast Guard. Long-time Fort Pierce residents remember the tower when it was located just East of Jetty Park and what was then the site of the old Beach Casino. Early in the war, before the Navy took over North and South Island, the tower was manned by civilians on lookout for German submarines and enemy aircraft.

It is our belief that tourists and locals alike will enjoy the view from the top and the significance of its history.
