ORDER OF CONTINUANCE

THIS MATTER came before the Board of Examiners of Contractors of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida (the "Board") for hearing on March 8, 2016, upon the Complaint filed by the Complainant, East Coast Lumber & Supply Co. against the Respondent, George Turenne, dba American Lighting Maintenance, Inc., dated December 15, 2015, and the Notice of Alleged Charges filed by the Building Official with the Building Department of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida (the "Department") dated February 24, 2016, based upon said Complaint. The Complainant, through its representative, and the Respondent appeared at said hearing. The Board, having received and heard the representations made by the Complainant, the Respondent, and the Department and being otherwise advised in the premises, makes the following findings and determinations:

A. The Respondent is a State of Florida certified electrical contractor.

B. At the commencement of the hearing, the Department advised, and the Complainant and the Respondent confirmed, that the parties have agreed upon a potential resolution of matters presented by the Complaint which, if so resolved, would cause the Complainant to seek the Board's dismissal of the Complaint.

C. In considering such findings, the Board, by unanimous vote, adopted a motion to continue said hearing to provide the parties with the opportunity to resolve matters presented by the Complaint. The Board further indicated that, if such matters are so resolved, a follow up evidentiary hearing would not be necessary and that, instead, upon being presented with the Department's report of such resolution, the Board will consider a dismissal of the Complaint and the charge(s) in the Notice of Alleged Charges. Accordingly, it is


ORDERED as follows:

1. The hearing before the Board be and the same is hereby continued pending the Board's receipt of a report from the Department on the status of a resolution of matters presented by the Complaint.

2. If the Department's report confirms that such matters presented by the Complaint have been resolved between the parties, then the Board will consider dismissing the Complaint and the charge(s) contained in the Notice of Alleged Charges against the Respondent.

3. If, however, the parties are unable to resolve such matters presented by the Complaint within a reasonable time period, the hearing shall be rescheduled before the Board with notice thereof to the parties.


