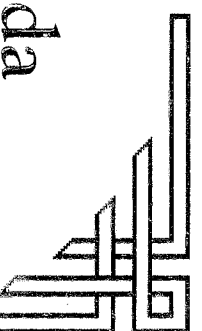

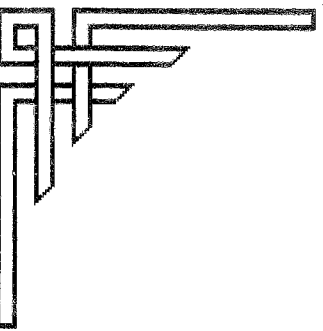
WHEREAS, the 50th Anniversary Gala will celebrate the power of faith, hope, and love, and assure the long-term health of this wonder-filled place of learning.
