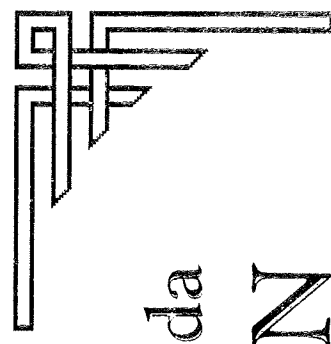

WHEREAS,

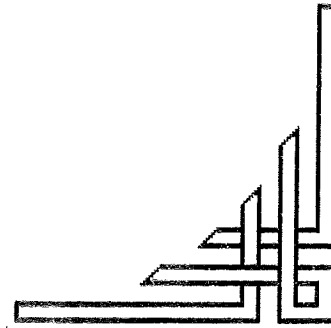
damage from a flood is not normally covered under a standard homeowners' policy, residents are encouraged to review flood risk and purchase flood insurance to protect their property.
