We came in on a Saturday and berthed in the older section with fixed wooden docks. With no tide to speak of, the wood fixed docks were just fine. A lot of the charter fishing boats were docked near us so when they came in and cleaned their catch, it was fun to watch the pelicans waiting for and fighting for the scraps. The electrical supply was solid. The WiFi signal could have been stronger but was adequate. The dockmaster and office staff were professional and more than helpful. Because we came in on a Saturday, we were treated with music from the band playing at the on site Tiki Hut. They were actually quite good; not blaring and loud, just pleasant to listen to. The docks were key gated and closed at night. The new floating docks have coded

gate doors that remain closed all the time. We never had any concerns about security. The town is an easy walk from the marina, the park and walkway next to it is very nice. When we had to delay our departure a day due to weather, the marina was most accommodating. We'd definitely stay here again if our travels take us this way.
