### **Common Good Initiative Investments – Lincoln Park**

*In each of the Common Good Communities, we have begun to award grants, and provide financial support through grant-related activities, while we work with the communities to identify priorities and strategies.*

### **Lincoln Park Investments – Total \$254,033**

#### **Total FY16 to date (July 1, 2015 – May 31, 2016): \$50,113**

- \$1,500 to Lighthouse Foundation for food to feed volunteers of Restoring the Village Community Revitalization Day–June 18
- \$750 to PureEgo Films to video tape Restoring the Village Community Revitalization Day-June 18
- \$5,000 for Hendley My Life Matters Enrichment Summer Camp
- \$5,000 for Image of Christ Summer Broadcasting Program
- \$5,000 to the City of Fort Pierce to restore the village entrance-way sign.
- \$1,000 to Eckerd Kids to support Project Bridge Transition – Children’s Hero of the Year Awards
- \$5,000 SWORD Outreach Mentoring for Higher Learning and Community Opportunities.
- \$5,000 From Boys to Men Foundation for the purchase of uniforms for youth and to support the Launching.
- \$5,000 Roundtable of St. Lucie County to support 50 youth attending the Preventing Crime in the Black Community Conference – Youth Leadership Project.
- \$1,003 Zion’s Daughters of Distinction for HIV/AIDS Training and Certification
- \$360 to Roundtable of St. Lucie County for sponsorship breakfast in Lincoln Park community
- \$5,000 Boys and Girls Club of St. Lucie County sponsorship for Infinity Club/thank you and fundraising receptions.
- \$1,500 Friends of St. Lucie Public Health for Annual Children’s Holiday Fest in the Lincoln Park Area.
- \$4,000 Tri County Chapter of Parents of Murdered Children for community residents to attend the National Conference of Parents of Murdered Children
- \$5,000 City of Fort Pierce for the purchase of sports equipment for the Summer Slam Basketball Program.

**Total in FY15: \$203,920**

- \$120,000 to Roundtable of St. Lucie County for two Street Outreach Workers in the Restoring the Village Gang Initiative.
- \$15,000 to Roundtable of St. Lucie County for general operating support of the Lincoln Park Advisory Committee. Funds will also be used for activities to engage the community, such as community memorial gardens, surveys, etc.
- \$10,000 to St. Lucie County Board of County Commissioners for Lincoln Park Community Center "A Time to C.H.I.L.L." Youth Summit.
- \$41,950 to City of Fort Pierce for matching grants to 9 organizations receiving Public Service Awards for primarily youth-driven and youth-serving projects.
- \$5,000 to In the Image of Christ for a mentoring trip for young men who live in the Lincoln Park community.
- \$500 to Lincoln Park Academy, honorarium for hosting community meeting; funds to be used to improve the school environment.
- \$5,000 to Boys and Girls Club of St. Lucie County for staff of the Infinity Club to attend the National Boys and Girls Clubs Conference, to enhance their skills and provide better services for youth at the Club.
- \$1,470 to Roundtable of St. Lucie County, for the Lincoln Park Advisory Committee to create and maintain a community mobilization and resource guide for Lincoln Park residents and youth that can be accessed through an "app" for smart phones and other electronic devices.
- \$5,000 to Community Outreach Youth Program, Inc. for Camp Destiny/ Camp Lincoln Park Summer Camp – 8 week program for Lincoln Park children age 4-18 in an environment that encourages advanced thinking, creative problem solving.
