# Allegany Franciscan Ministries

Allegany Franciscan Ministries is a non-profit Catholic organization with 8 staff, and offices in Tampa Bay, West Palm Beach and Miami. Allegany Franciscan Ministries grew out of the health care ministries of the Franciscan Sisters of Allegany, New York, and is a member of Community Health. It provides grants and resources in the three regions of Florida formerly served by the Sisters' hospitals. Since 1998, Allegany has invested over \$76 million to 1300+ organizations to improve access to health and health care. In 2014, while continuing its traditional grant-making activities, Allegany launched the Common Good Initiative, a long-term, community-driven, place-based effort mobilizing communities towards better health and wellness.
