Dear Mayor and Commissioners,

We are requesting an additional 12 month's time to pay on the above mentioned lien reductions. In regards to the history of these Code Enforcement liens. We bought this property with these liens attached and thought that the city would be lenient and dismiss the fines knowing that we trying to improve this derelict, rundown abandoned property. But, unfortunately we were still fined \$2500.00 and we have had no choice but to accept the fine and make payment arrangements.

Over the last ten months it has been extremely difficult on us financially. The cost to trying to rehab this property went way above our expected estimate, and we our still trying to do repairs that continue to emerge. As well as unforeseen costs that have involved the cost for my father's funeral, a busted sewer line under my home and many other unexpected financial burdens that have plagued us recently. And please keep in mind that we were still trying to send payments to the city for these liens on top of our living expenses.

Finally, we have paid \$650.00 towards these liens as of September 2nd 2016. We our pleading with you to please drop the rest of these fines knowing that we were not the cause and that we are only trying to rehabilitate our neighborhood to keep it a decent place to live in the City of Ft Pierce or at minimum please grant us an additional 12 months.
