

RESOLUTION NO. 16-R49

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE **ST. LUCIE COUNTY LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY PLAN**; DIRECTING CITY CLERK TO PROVIDE A COPY TO ST. LUCIE COUNTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA2K) requires that all communities, tribes and states have a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved hazard mitigation plan, consistent with the SMA2K requirements, to retain eligibility for FEMA hazard mitigation grant funding; and

WHEREAS, a Florida Department of Emergency Management (FDEM) approved hazard mitigation plan is required for the purpose of certifying compliance with the requirements of the National Flood Insurance Rate Program; and

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2016, FDEM found the St. Lucie County Local Mitigation Strategy Plan compliant with federal standards subject to formal adoption; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2016, St. Lucie County formally adopted the plan by Resolution 16-094.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby adopts the St. Lucie County Local Mitigation Strategy Plan as adopted by St. Lucie County on June 7, 2016.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to provide a copy to St. Lucie County Department of Public Safety.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
