On behalf of the Lincoln Park Main Street (LPMS) Board of Directors would like to say "Thank You" to the City of Fort Pierce for your continued support for program activities with the beautiful lighted decorations along the Avenue D corridor; and at the Christmas on Moore's Creek event. The newly Christmas on Moore's Creek event held on Saturday, December 17, 2016 at the popular venue Moore's Creek Linear Park could not have experienced the success without the City of Fort Pierce as a title sponsor. The partnership with the City of Fort Pierce and Florida Health in St. Lucie County delivered a record breaking event for attendance and activities. Other strategic public entity partners included Fort Pierce Utilities Authority, St. Lucie County, Council on Aging, and the Housing Authority of City of Fort Pierce. Community partners included Jackson Hewitt, Allegany Franciscan Ministries, Friends of the St. Lucie County Public Health, Guys Quality Meats, Fort Pierce Shrine Club No. 69 Masud Temple, American Legion Post 171 and Bounce World.

The first annual Christmas on Moore's Creek witnessed a record 1,039 attendees; which included 620 kids, 345 parents/adults, and 54 volunteers. Approximately 1,300 hotdogs were served along with buns and condiments; and 1,000 bottles of water and 2,000 bags of popcorn and cotton candy. Toys were collected from the City of Fort Pierce employees, Friends of St. Lucie County Public Health, and Lincoln Park Main Street. City Employee Dan Briganti and friends from a couple of Car Clubs from Port St. Lucie was instrumental in collecting toys for this event. The area was nicely decorated with a Christmas Tree and Lights hanging around the tree. On hand was a Santa for the kids and entertainment and a kids zone which included bounce houses, pony and hay rides, popcorn and cotton candy.
