

RESOLUTION NO. 17-R13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, STATING THE CITY AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) ARE DESIROUS OF ENTERING INTO A LOCALLY FUNDED AGREEMENT AND A THREE PARTY ESCROW AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE FOR THE **INSTALLATION OF PEDESTRIAN OBSERVATION DECK LIGHTING** AS PART OF THE DEPARTMENT'S BRIDGE REHABILITATION WORK OF THE SR A1A – PETER P. COBB MEMORIAL BRIDGE, PROJECT # 426840-1-52-02, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CITY CLERK AND CITY ATTORNEY TO ENTER AND EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT ON THE PART OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, this Locally Funded Agreement and a Three Party Escrow Agreement are in the interest of both the City of Fort Pierce and the Florida Department of Transportation to make certain improvements in connection with the Department's bridge rehabilitation of the SR A1A – Peter P. Cobb Memorial Bridge in St. Lucie County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, The City of Fort Pierce has requested the Department perform the following additional work: Construction (installation) of pedestrian observation deck lighting on said bridge; and

WHEREAS the improvements are in the interest of both the City and the Department and it would be more practical, expeditious, and economical for the Department to perform such activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, as follows:

1. That the City of Fort Pierce will enter into a State of Florida Department of Transportation Locally Funded Agreement and a Three Party Escrow Agreement for the improvements.
2. The City of Fort Pierce's share for the project is in the estimated amount of Three Hundred Two Thousand and Seven Hundred Fifty Three Dollars and No Cents (\$302,753.00)
3. That the Mayor, City Clerk and City Attorney are hereby authorized to enter into said agreements and to execute said agreements on behalf of the City of Fort Pierce.
