On Saturday, October 28, the City of Fort Pierce kicked-off the gardening season with a re-launch of the Community Garden located at 424 N. 9th Street at Moore's Creek. Even with the threat of rain looming, 16 out of the 24 smaller plots were snatched up at the kick-off! This was a collaborative effort that will work towards reversing the food desert in the Lincoln Park neighborhood of Fort Pierce. The Parks & Grounds Division worked hard to make sure the new irrigation system was ready and that the available plots were cleared. University of Florida's IFAS provided educational materials, lettuce seedlings and starter kits for all who signed up. St. Lucie County provided free banana trees, and

SLC Master Gardeners provided so much education and actually helped start your garden! The Manatee Observation and Educational Center sold plants and were on hand providing education on Moore's Creek runoff into the St. Lucie River. The Lincoln Park Community has limited access to healthy foods, however, there are plenty of

convenience stores that promote unhealthy eating. Our Community Garden and future fresh food initiatives should play a major role in reducing the food desert in our community. 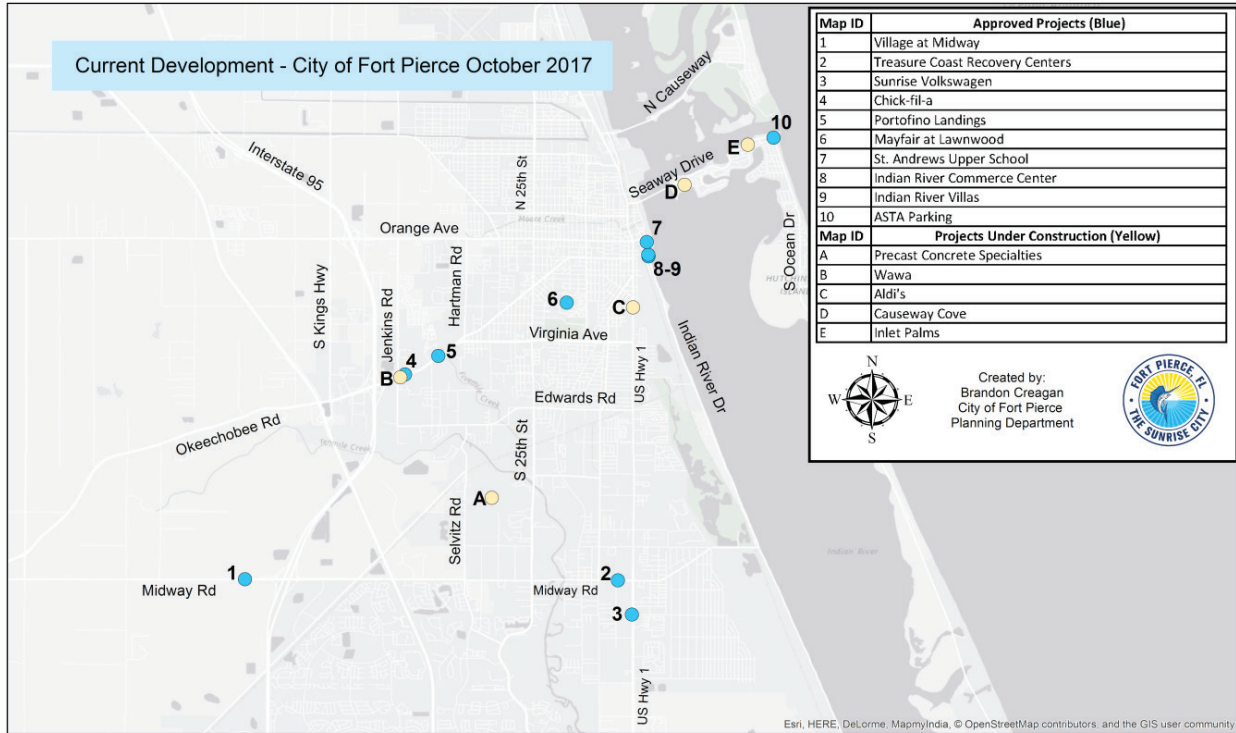

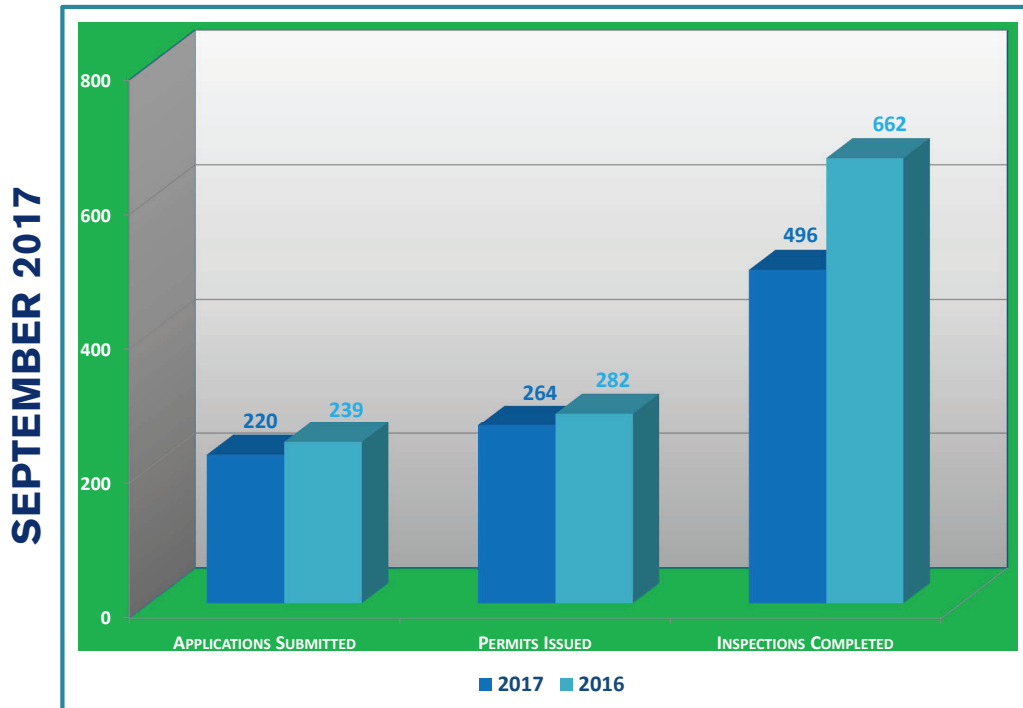

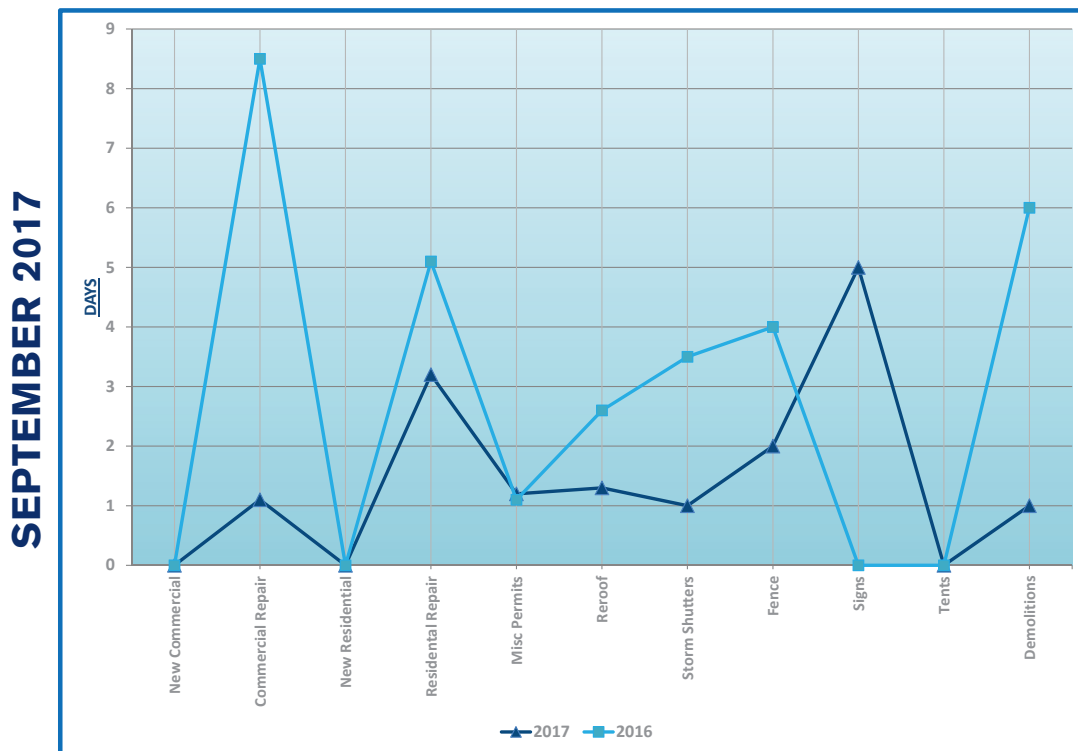

Tis' The Season

The City of Fort Pierce continues to deal with the effects of Hurricane Irma with the Public Works Department staff working diligently to remove all of the storm generated debris as quickly as possible. Crews have been working 6 days a week with every available resource to accomplish this enormous task. To date, approximately 80% of the material has been removed.

Leading up to the public unveiling of the painted pots in the Peacock Arts District, Parks and Grounds Division employees were busy placing the pots along the PAD, planting the trees within them and also concealing them until the big day. Much of this work was done in the wee hours of the morning to ensure that the artwork was not seen by the community until after the wonderful artists who participated in this project were recognized.

The Public Works Department along with the Keep Fort Pierce Beautiful Advisory Board are excited to announce a new partnership with St. Lucie County and the University of Florida IFAS Extension to promote sustainable gardening within the community. A kickoff event was held on October 28, 2017 at the Community Garden with local Master Gardener's providing education and answering questions as well as starter kits for those who wish to have a plot. The PWD Team has added automatic irrigation to each plot effectively reducing the number of visits to the garden each participant would have to make to maintain their crop.

The holiday season is quickly approaching and the PWD is hard at work to ensure that the displays this year are just as beautiful as years past. Restorations are being made to some of the items that are in inventory and brainstorming sessions are taking place to make this year the best one yet.

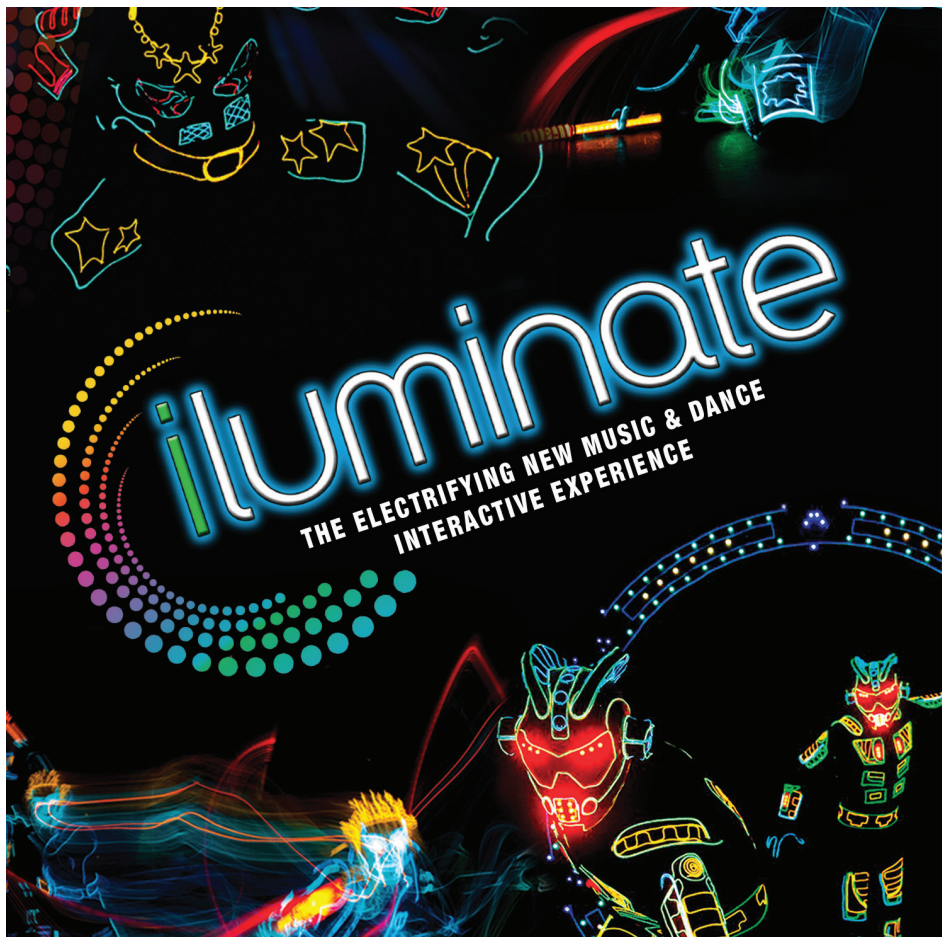
