

RESOLUTION NO. 17-RXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, PROVIDING A DUAL DESIGNATION OF 13TH STREET TO BE ALSO KNOWN AS CHURCH STREET; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 6th, 1923, the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce advanced a series of street name conversions, and associated house numbering guidelines, in the adoption of Ordinance A-6; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive system adopted for street and roadway nomenclature to guide navigation and organization is important for overall retention to the community; and

WHEREAS, 13th Street is home to several churches within the City of Fort Pierce; and

WHEREAS, at the Commission Meeting on September 5, 2017, several Fort Pierce ministers requested that the Mayor and Commission consider renaming 13th Street to Church Street and presented a community petition to do so; and

WHEREAS, all 190 property owners along 13th Street were provided notice of the potential renaming of the Street and given an opportunity to express their support or opposition; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owners responded to the notification with _____ in support and _____ in opposition of renaming 13th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, that 13th Street be granted a dual designation of 13th Street and Church Street from Zephyr Avenue to its terminus at Moore's Creek.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
