I wanted to let you know that I have heard many expressions of thanks from South Beach residents for the efforts of FPPD Officers following Irma. These included comments about the professionalism demonstrated by Officers controlling bridge access until things were under control and residents had an opportunity to inspect and protect their property. The handling of unusual situations at the barricade, such as those not prepared with disaster access cards and non resident property managers or contractors trying to reach client properties they served on the island, was appropriate and professional. But, most often mentioned, was the presence of both marked and plain wrap units constantly moving thru the community with roof bars active and spotlights and alley lights being used to check open areas and hidden spots throughout the night where power was off. Those who were here trying to get thru the hot humid night with windows and doors open or with damage allowing easy access to their property slept much better and with a feeling of security because of your efforts, myself included.

It is, of course, impossible for me to list the names of those Officers working our zone. But, I have also heard similar comments about other areas of the city, some with flooding issues we did not have, and I am sure that our thanks is echoed from all areas and directed at all Officers serving the community.

Please let your Officers know their efforts and consideration of community needs over their own personal concerns during this time is recognized and appreciated.
