As a follow up to the Paradise Park Street Lighting discussions at a recent City Commission meeting, the following information has been compiled regarding St. Lucie County's Street Lighting District program.

In order to offer and fund street lighting in the Paradise Park neighborhood, St. Lucie County created the Paradise Park Street Lighting District (SLD) in 1982. This district was formed to cover the monthly operating and maintenance costs of street lights within the Paradise Park boundary. This SLD was created prior to the Paradise Park neighborhood being annexed into the City of Fort Pierce.

When 17 of the County's 19 SLDs were created, annual assessment amounts were based on ad-valorem value (the 1982 resolution). However, as property values declined around 2008, so did assessment collections. In 2010, the SLDs were changed to non-ad valorem because the County was not collecting sufficient funds to cover the monthly FPUA/FPL invoices. Annual assessment amounts are now determined by dividing the total annual cost of each SLD by the number of parcels within each SLD.

St. Lucie County has informed us that as long as street lights are intact, there is no end date for this SLD. This issue will be included in future annexation negotiations with St. Lucie County.

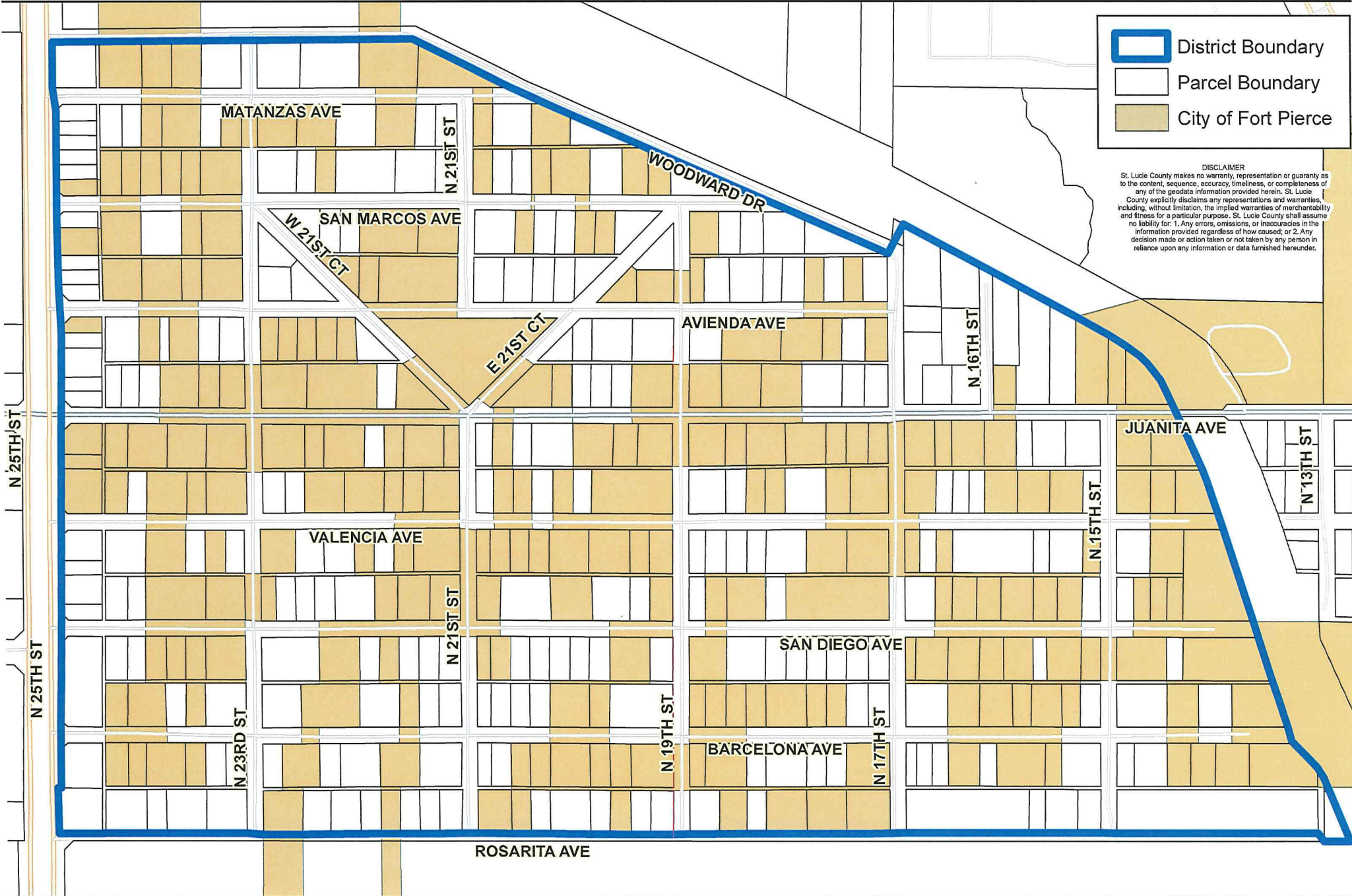
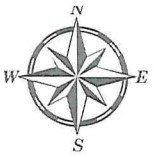
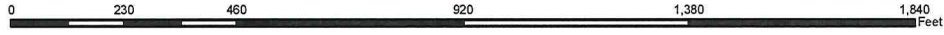

## RESOLUTION NO. 82-57

A resolution validating and confirming the creation of Special Improvement Service District No. 8 of St. Lucie County and authorizing the levy of special assessments on all real property in the District, including homestead, on an ad valorem basis of not more than \$3.00 per \$1,000 annually on the assessed value of said property

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Lucie County, Florida, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 72-2 of St. Lucie County, as amended, by its resolution duly and regularly adopted at its meeting held on March 16, 1982, did call an election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors residing within the hereinafter described District for their approval or disapproval the creation and establishment of Special Improvement Service District No. 8 of St. Lucie County, Florida, and the furnishing of street lights as set forth in said resolution and financed as therein provided, and such resolution further provided and did direct that notice of such election be given by publication in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, due and regular notice of such special election was published in the News Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation published in St. Lucie County, said publication having been made in such newspaper once each week for four consecutive weeks on March 22 and 29 and April 5 and 12, 1982, the first publication thereof being not less than thirty days prior to April 20, 1982, the date of such special election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid resolution calling such election and in accordance with law, the question of the creation and establishment of said district was submitted to the qualified electors residing in said District at a special election on April 20, 1982, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said election was duly and properly held in accordance with law and that the votes cast therein have been returned, delivered and canvassed, and that the returns from said election have been delivered to this Board for the purpose of canvassing said election returns and determining and certifying the results thereof; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the total number of votes cast in said election by the qualified electors residing in said District was Fifty-Eight (58); and

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-181**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE PROVISION OF STREET LIGHTING SERVICES, IMPROVEMENTS AND FACILITIES IN THE PARADISE PARK STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT AND THE FUNDING THEREOF THROUGH THE IMPOSITION OF NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS; RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 82-57; DETERMINING THAT CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY WILL BE SPECIALLY BENEFITED BY THE STREET LIGHTING SERVICES; APPROVING THE METHOD OF ASSESSING THE COST OF SUCH SERVICES AGAINST THE REAL PROPERTY SPECIALLY BENEFITTED THEREBY; APPROVING THE ASSESSMENT ROLL AND DIRECTING CERTIFICATION THEREOF TO THE TAX COLLECTOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1. AUTHORITY.** This resolution is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Article VI, Chapter 1-17 of the St. Lucie County Code of Ordinances (the "Ordinance"), County Resolution No. 82-57, Sections 125.01, 125.66 and 197.3632, Florida Statutes, and other applicable provisions of law.

**SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.** This resolution constitutes the Annual Assessment Resolution as defined in the Ordinance. All capitalized words and terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the Ordinance. Unless the context indicates otherwise, words imparting the singular number, include the plural number, and vice versa.

**SECTION 3. FINDINGS.** It is hereby ascertained, determined, and declared as follows:

(A) On April 27, 1982, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of St. Lucie County, Florida (the "County") adopted Resolution No. 82-57 which established the Paradise Park Street Lighting District (the "District") as a special improvement service district and provided for the imposition of special assessments to fund the cost of providing street lighting services, improvements and facilities therein. A map describing the boundary of the District is attached hereto as Appendix A.

(B) On May 11, 2010, the Board enacted the Ordinance to revise the procedure by which special assessments are imposed within special improvement service districts for purposes of funding street lighting services. Such revised procedure requires adoption of an Annual Assessment Resolution each Fiscal Year approving the Assessment Roll for the District.

(C) The Ordinance further provides that in the event the Board desires to implement an alternative apportionment methodology for allocating the cost of Street Lighting Services among the

(1) The District is substantially composed of similarly-sized single family residential parcels. Accordingly, each single family residential parcel shall constitute one equivalent dwelling unit (EDU) for purposes of allocating the cost of providing the Street Lighting Services therein.

(2) Individual multifamily units within the District are specially benefitted by Street Lighting Services in the same manner and to substantially the same extent as single family residential parcels, such that each multifamily unit shall constitute one EDU. Individual tax parcels which contain multifamily units shall be assigned one EDU per multifamily unit.

(3) The amount of the Assessment per EDU shall be calculated by dividing the total estimated cost of providing the Street Lighting Service by the number of EDUs in the District.

(4) As of the date hereof, there are 438 EDUs located within the District.

(5) For the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2010, the estimated cost of providing Street Lighting Services in the District is \$13,604.28. Such estimated cost includes a component to fund or otherwise reimburse the County for costs incurred in administering and maintaining the Assessment program as authorized by Section 1-17-82 of the Ordinance.

(6) The maximum amount of the Assessments to be assessed and apportioned among the parcels of real property within the District is hereby established in the amount of \$31.06 per EDU for the Fiscal Year 2010-11.

(B) Annual Assessment Resolutions for subsequent Fiscal Years may approve annual cost of living or inflationary increases in the amount of the Assessment by a cumulative total of not to exceed 10% of the amount approved hereunder, or a total annual Assessment of \$34.17, without requiring additional notice and public hearing prior to adoption of such Annual Assessment Resolutions, as authorized by Section 1-17-79 of the Ordinance.

(C) The apportionment methodology approved herein shall be utilized in preparing the Assessment Roll for the District for subsequent Fiscal Years.

**SECTION 5. RATIFICATION AND CONFIRMATION OF DISTRICT BOUNDARY AND RESOLUTION NO. 82-57. The legal description of the boundary of the District as set forth in Resolution No. 82-57, including any amendment thereto, is hereby ratified, confirmed and**

**SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY.** If any clause, section, or other part of this resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this resolution.

**SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Annual Assessment Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
