

RESOLUTION NO. 18-RXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, **VOIDING APPOINTMENTS MADE IN ERROR AND CERTIFYING THE APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER TO THE CONSTRUCTION BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS AND APPEALS**; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida adopted Resolution 18-R08 appointing members to the Construction Board of Adjustment and Appeals; and

WHEREAS, it was discovered that the term of James Langel currently serving as the Mechanical Contractor representative was not expired and Robert Allen was appointed as the mechanical contractor in error; and

WHEREAS, it was subsequently determined that the position of “consumer representative” was not limited to non-industry applications as is the case for the Board of Examiners of Contractors and therefore additional applications should have been considered and Annmarie Collins was appointed as the consumer representative in error; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to provide the proper opportunity for all qualified applicants to be considered, the City Clerk is recommending that the City Commission reconsider and select a Consumer Representative from all qualified applications.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, as follows:

1. There is no current Mechanical Contractor vacancy therefore Mr. Robert Allen’s appointment as a mechanical contractor via 18-R08 is void.
2. Ms. Annmarie Collins was appointed as a consumer representative without proper consideration of all applicants so her appointment via 18-R08 is void.
3. Following consideration and a vote of all eligible applicants, _____ is hereby appointed by the City Commission to serve a member of the Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals as the Consumer/General Public Representative; said term to commence upon adoption of this resolution and to expire on March 1, 2022, or when a successor has been duly appointed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
