ATC Group Services, LLC (ATC) is pleased to provide you with this cost proposal for the removal and installation of two (2)-12000 gallon fuel storage tanks, at the Public Works facility located at 52 Savannah Road, Fort Pierce, Florida. We are State Licensed Storage Tank Contractors and have completed several similar projects in the Tampa Bay area and other parts of the State for over 10+ years. We are also Licensed Engineers in the State of Florida and provide both engineering as well as construction services which very few storage tank installers provide. ATC Personnel have visited the site and reviewed the scope of work to be completed. Our scope includes cleaning and disposal of the two (2) existing fuel tanks at a metal recycling facility with a waste manifest provided for your records. We propose to install two (2) -12,000 gallons Cylindrical Double Wall Fireguard UL-2085 fuel tanks (8.5 ft. Dia X 9.5 ft. Tall X 33 ft. long) manufactured by Highland Tank Manufacturing Company, on the existing slab. A brochure of the Fireguard Tank is included for your reference. All existing tank accessories will be transferred to the new tank, including the existing Veeder Root ATG, level probe, and STP. The new tanks will be equipped with a 3 inch Remote Fill Port bolted and piped to the tank including a 3 inch overfill prevention valve with quick connect, dust cap and drop tube assembly. Following installation, the fuel tanks will be started up for use.
