

RESOLUTION NO. 18-R37

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT APPOINTEES MUST RESIDE WITHIN THE DISTRICT OF THE APPOINTING COMMISSIONER FOR THE **POLICE COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE**; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission created the Police Community Advisory Committee by Resolution 18-R32; and

WHEREAS, after discussion on July 16, 2018, the Commission voted to remove the requirement that the Commissioner appointees must reside within their respective district as described in Section 7, numbers (3) and (7) of Resolution 18-R32.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida that Section 7 of Resolution 18-R32 is revised as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7(3) of Resolution 18-R32 is revised to read as follows:

Following the receipt of applications the Mayor and each City Commissioner shall nominate one applicant ~~from within their respective Districts~~ and shall announce their nominee during a regular or Special Commission meeting.

SECTION 2. Section 7(7) of Resolution 18-R32 is revised to read as follows:

Should a member resign, be removed in accordance with section 10, or otherwise be unable to serve, the appointing Commissioner or Mayor will select a qualified replacement ~~from within their district~~.

SECTION 3. All other provisions of Resolution 18-R32 remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity of that section does not affect other provisions or applications of this act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are severable.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
