ORDINANCE NO. 18-029 AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE VII OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "PERMIT FEES"; AMENDING SECTION 5-266, TO CLARIFY DETERMINATION OF FEES AND VALUATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 5-267, TO UPDATE FEE COLLECTION, REORGANIZE SCHEDULE AND REMOVE FEES NOT INCLUSIVE TO PERMITS; CREATING SECTION 5-268, MISCELLANEOUS FEE SCHEDULE, TO PROVIDE FOR A SCHEDULE OF MISCELLANEOUS FEES NOT INCLUSIVE TO PERMITS; CREATING SECTION 5-269, INCENTIVE AND OPTIONAL SERVICE FEE SCHEDULE, TO PROVIDE FOR A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR INCENTIVES AND OPTIONAL SERVICES THAT THE DEPARTMENT PROVIDES; CREATING SECTION 5-270, PENALTY FEE SCHEDULE, TO PROVIDE FOR A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR PENALTIES THAT MAY BE ASSESSED DURING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

All interested parties may appear at the meeting and be heard with respect to the Amendment of the Code of Ordinances. Said Ordinance will be available for inspection in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 100 North U.S. #1, Fort Pierce, Florida.
