

RESOLUTION NO. 18-R44

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE **RETURNS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION** HELD ON AUGUST 28, 2018, AS PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 67(1) of the City Charter provides that at the first regular meeting of the City Commission after the primary election and the general election, the City Commission shall adopt a Resolution accepting the returns as provided by the County Supervisor of Elections to the City Clerk, such returns having been canvassed by the County Canvassing Board, and declaring the outcome of the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce does hereby accept the returns of the Primary Election held on August 28, 2018, as provided by the County Supervisor of Elections, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A and made a part of this Resolution, such returns having been canvassed by the County Canvassing Board, declaring the outcome of the election.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
