**FLORIDA SUPREME COURT ORDERS AMENDMENT 6 TO BE PLACED BACK ON  
THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 BALLOT:**

In our newsletter for September 20, 2018, we advised that a Leon County Circuit Judge had held that amendment 6 was to be stricken from the ballot due to prohibited “logrolling.” The Supreme Court now has reversed the lower court, and ordered that the

amendment be placed back on the November 6<sup>th</sup> ballot. Amendment 6 would, *inter alia*, require judges and hearing officers independently to interpret rather than deferring to an agency's interpretation.
