

RESOLUTION NO. 19-R19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA, STATING THE CITY AND THE **FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT)** ARE DESIROUS OF ENTERING INTO A FLORIDA SHARED-USE NONMOTORIZED TRAIL GRANT AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE FOR THE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE RETROFIT OF THE SHELL ROCK **TRAIL AT INDIAN HILLS RECREATION AREA**, TO CONCRETE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CITY CLERK, AND CITY ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT ON THE PART OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, this Agreement is in the interest of both the City of Fort Pierce and the Florida Department of Transportation enabling the Department's participation in the improvement to the trails at the Indian Hills Recreation Area;

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation will provide funding for the retrofit determining it would be more practical, expeditious, and economical for the City of Fort Pierce to perform the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, as follows:

1. That the City of Fort Pierce will enter into a Florida Shared-Use Nonmotorized Trail Network Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for the mutual benefits to be derived from joint participation on the project
2. That a copy of said Agreement shall be attached to this Resolution.
3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
4. That the Mayor, City Clerk, and City Attorney are hereby authorized to enter into said agreement and to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Fort Pierce.
