## Legislative Policy Committees

Each year, municipal officials from across the state volunteer to serve on the League's five Legislative policy committees. Appointments are typically a one-year commitment and involve developing the League's Legislative Action Agenda detailing priority issues that are most likely to affect daily municipal governance and local decision making during the upcoming legislative session. 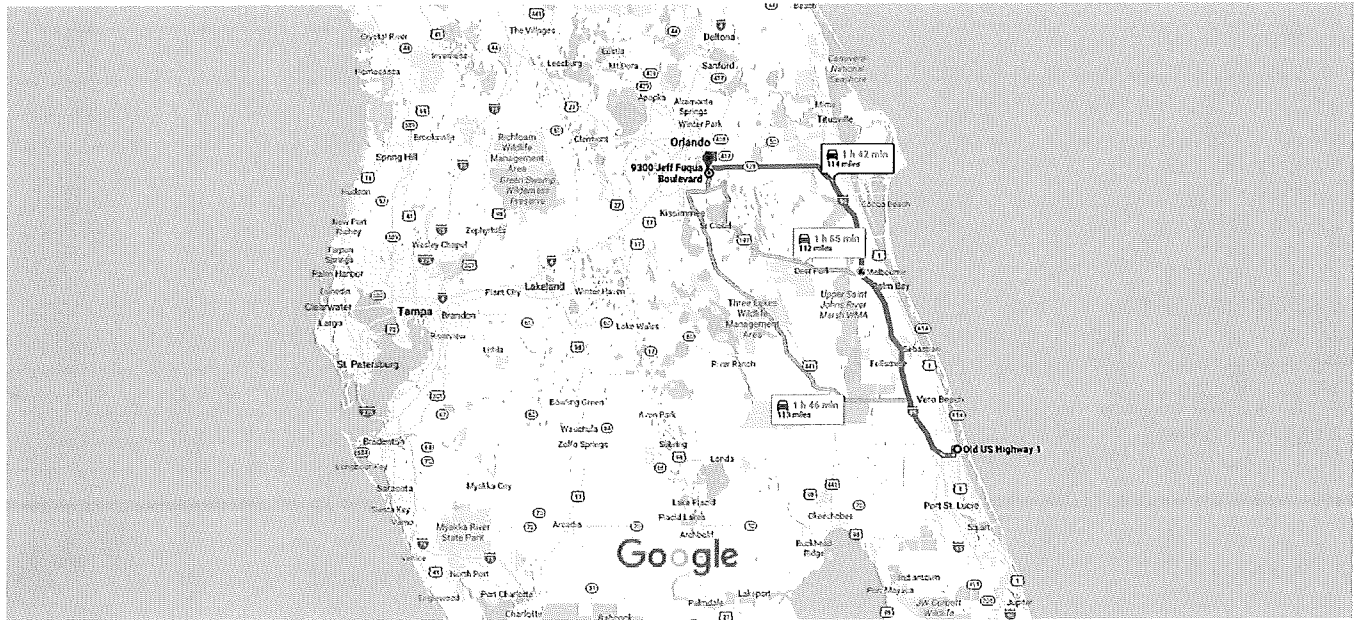
