
Dear Chief Hobley-Burney,

We are writing this letter to commend one of your officers, Detective Jesse Streeter. Just so you are aware, we have had custody of our, now three year old granddaughter, Ariyah Huff (Ari) for most of her life. On June 10, 2017, the parents were asked to leave our house because of a one sided argument. They took Ari with them. Nine days later, Ari was returned to our home. Subsequently, we took her to the hospital and found that her arm was broken in two places. Ari was just 10 ½ months old at the time, and could not tell us how this happened. That all changed in March 2019. Ariyah, now two and a half, started saying that her mommy had hurt her arm. We were at a loss of what to do. Since the injury occurred in your city, we reached out to the detective bureau for assistance. This was our first contact with Detective Streeter. We found him to be compassionate, empathetic and an extremely diligent lifesaver. Detective Streeter went right to work to get justice for Ariyah, and would not stop until charges were brought against the mother. We feel he is Ari's Guardian Angel. You could not ask for a better investigator. He kept us abreast of what was happening, and was always available day or night to hear our concerns. While this case is not over, hopefully we will, with the Grace of God, adopt Ariyah.

Jesse will always have a place in our hearts for the extra mile he went to save Ari. He is a true Guardian Angel sent from God, and an asset to your great department. Thank you so much!
